- 2 Are you searching for the character of God? Your behavior will be determined by your understanding of the character of your God. That's a statement that cannot be successfully argued with.**
- 3. Are you finding things to be joyful and happy about? You should be encountering things that make your heart soar! For instance: Nothing can separate us from the love of God; God's grace is bigger than all our sin; the Lord Jesus wants His people to spend eternity with Him in his father's house!**

**Let me encourage you to treat God's Word like what it is – a book full of wonderful things for God's people, the chief of which is God Himself!**

**MISSION CORNER:** Deaf Missions is truly a story of God at work. Duane King, Founder of Deaf Missions first met Deaf people while serving as minister of First Christian Church in Norfolk, Nebraska. During the Christmas season of 1966 Duane was asked to deliver an anonymous cash gift to some deaf people. From this first meeting with Emery and Louise Booth came the challenge to reach them and other Deaf people with the Gospel of Jesus. By 1970, God's call was so strong on Duane's heart that he knew he had to minister with Deaf people full time – on March 28, 1970, Deaf Missions was born. Two other important ministries were started soon after. Christ's Church of the Deaf was started in Council Bluffs, Iowa, in July of 1971. Deaf Missions welcomed Deaf people and their families and friends to our annual Bible Camp for the Deaf from 1971 to 2014. Deaf Missions has also helped other groups to begin Deaf churches and camps in other states. After 37 yrs of leading Deaf Missions in November of 2007, Duane turned over the directorship to Chad Entinger. Chad is Deaf and highly regarded by both Deaf & hearing people. Deaf Missions is a noted and respected leader among ministries, and its outreach extends through more than 60 denominations; impacting the lives of the Deaf in all 50 states and more than 90 countries around the world.
