MISSION CORNER: *Bible Sticks*

William Carey, known as the father of modern missions, recognized that the commercial and political expansion and the religious revival of his day provided the perfect context to launch a missionary movement (Pierson, 1992). Multiple leaders have followed in Careys' footsteps, calling the church to evangelism and world missions. For example, Bill Bright, founder of Campus Crusade for Christ International, signed his letters,

"Yours for Fulfilling the Great Commission in this Generation."

Wasn't that a little crazy?

Today there is a vision and strategy to translate a portion of Scripture in every language that needs it by 2033. Faith Comes By Hearing is aligning with this strategy by launching Vision 2033. It is our desire to have an Audio Recording of Scripture in every language by 2033.

An Audio Bible allows the estimated 70% of the world's population who live in oral communities or who do not read to hear and understand the Word of God. To achieve the 2033 goal, we will look to God for help and wisdom, ramp up our systems, prepare our team, and expand our faith. Over the next five years, FCBH will gradually increase the number of languages we record each year.

A few years ago recording 1,000 languages was a highly ambitious goal, but together we got there! Reaching this new goal of an Audio Recording in every language looks and feels equally ambitious, but we are confident that it is attainable. We look forward to sharing the journey with you.
