**Nagaland Children's Outreach
Nagaland Children's Outreach was founded in 2006 in Nagaland, India with the intent of caring for "hill country" orphans, educating them, and leading them to the Lord. This is the first Christian orphanage in Nagaland that accepts orphans from the hill country.**

Run by Eliilo Patton, the Nagaland orphanage is raising 8 children, ranging from elementary to high school ages. It also does a number of community outreach events that draw Muslims and Hindus to participate.
