I want to encourage you to read Psalm 73. It is a very open admission of envy of the wicked rich. It is also a cure for envy. In it the writer says, "as for me, my feet had almost slipped; for I envied the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked."

He then states that they are, "...always carefree, they increase in wealth" and then draws the conclusion that keeping one's heart pure is a waste of time, "Surely in vain I have kept my heart pure." Maybe you haven't felt exactly like that but the apparent blessing of the wicked and the suffering of the righteous has always been a problem for God's people.

That problem bothered the Psalmist, "till I entered the sanctuary of God; then I understood their final destiny" ("How suddenly are they destroyed").

The lessons from this Psalm are clear: 1. Don't envy the rich or the wicked. 2. We are often fooled by the temporary circumstances of life. 3. It's the "final destiny" issue that defines life, not riches or any other temporary blessing. 4. Our thinking can be a form of betrayal of our values and our confidence in God's wisdom and justice. It is also a form of betrayal of God's people who are holding tightly to His Word. "If I had said, "I will speak thus" I would have betrayed your children."

Live your life the solid rock of God's Word. Let it saturate your thinking and dreaming and your evaluation of earthly circumstances.
