It's a different experience for me to be on the receiving end of so many people praying for me. I really like it when people sincerely say that they are praying for me and have asked others to do the same. I started radiation this week and will be finished in mid-July. Thank you for your prayers.

I'm a believer in asking questions of the text when one reads or studies the Bible. Always ask who, what, when, etc. questions. They will clarify the text for you and enable you to get more out of it and you will get a more accurate understanding of the text.

But I would like to suggest a few other questions for people who are really serious about applying the Word of God to their lives. I have found 10 Great Questions but I'll just write about two in this article.

These two are rarely asked:

1. "What is the benefit if I do what this text says?" That's a great question because we often read what the Bible says and then move on. We just don't stop long enough to ask, "What is the benefit if I obey this text?" We often ask God for blessings. We often beg for help in making right choices or right decisions. What if we considered the blessing of obedience? Don't you think that will help you obey the scripture?
2. The second is like the first but the opposite side of the same coin. "What will it cost me if I don't obey this text?" Many people suggest using a "cost-benefit" way of making decisions. It seems to me to be a valid process, "What will it cost me?" These two questions, honestly pondered will prevent reading scripture for the sake of information and will help you cement yourself to obedience of the Word of God.

So, start asking questions today. You will really like the results.

MISSION CORNER: NIÑOS DE MEXICO

Niños de Mexico currently has six separate boys' and girls' homes as they raise 98 children ranging from the ages of 1 to 18. They have also added a Men's Dormitory home where three young college students live – One is studying to be a Criminologist; one an Architect in Interior Design and one studying Engineering in Mechatronics. Niños also operates Medical clinics for neighboring communities – Recently over 125 people were seen in three days time. Niños continues to plant churches. A new worship center was opened April 8, 2018. Members from all three of the existing congregations in the Puebla Mountain area were present to celebrate. A group representing the churches in the U.S. that have been a part of the outreach into this community were also present. Since the outreach began, over 100 people have come to Christ and there are now congregations in three villages where Jorge and his family hold services each Sunday. Continue to pray for Niños.
