1. Church planting – their main emphasis. They currently have 10!
2. Technical camps – motorcycle servicing and repair. They witness to the people who come to get their motorcycles fixed/serviced.
3. Mothers of Young Children Program – mainly Christian women attend. This is a time of encouragement and spiritual growth for them.
4. Children's ministry – C.A.R.E., they care for the needs of the poor and disowned children of India.
5. Benevolence – helping people who are victims of disasters
6. Evangelizing in Cincinnati – they are working on evangelizing the Indian community in Cincinnati.
7. Medical camps – medical aid and blind ministry
