### North Burma Christian Mission

During the month of May we will be highlighting NBCM and the work they are doing. Although they are living or "based" in Thailand, their ministry covers Thailand, India, Burma, China, and Laos! Really remarkable how much Joel and Marilyn are doing and how many churches they are involved in and setting up. Their ministry has been over 40 years in a very difficult region of the world as there are few Christians and they face many problems from other religions in the area: Buddhism, Islam, Hindus, Sikhs, and animists. A long held dream is finally becoming a reality as they are able to go from renting all these years to buying property and building a new home! The cost for building is approximately \$144,000 and because of generous gifts they have been able to accumulate \$100,000. They are in need of \$44,000 to complete the building in the next few months. They are requesting prayers and financial gifts towards this effort and their total ministry, and of course, they are very thankful to ERCC for all of our prayers and support in the past! May God continue to bless them and their ministry and may we, through, God continue to be used in this work.
