Ask your heart questions like this; Is my heart's deepest desire to know God better and better; Am I going through motions religion so that God will approve of me; Do I rest in His acceptance of me because He is gracious or am I looking for things to do so He will accept me?

Welcoming the heart attitude of Jesus into your life will put your questions and striving and lack of peace to rest. The place of peace is near the heart of our Savior.
