Luckner, born into a preacher's family in Haiti is the third of nine children. "Growing up, life was very difficult," he says. "In Haiti, preachers don't get paid. You just do it because you love Jesus. So feeding nine children was not easy." He dreamed of an education, but school was miles away and required tuition. "We didn't have money for tuition but if you recruited five paying students, the school gave you a scholarship. So I found other students." He walked hours back and forth to school each day. Luckner smiles, "I made it all the way through my senior year. Since childhood, my dream was to preach Jesus. As John 15 says, I want to be a productive branch for the Lord." He applied to OCC's International Student Grant and then prayed hard. "I contacted Ozark, explained my passion for ministry, and I was accepted!" Luckner moved in with a host family and began working for OCC's custodial crew for living expenses. (Though he only makes minimum wage he sends much of it to his family in Haiti.) Language was a challenge but he worked hard and his English is now outstanding. Luckner is already building a team. He recruited his cousin Vladimir Louis-Jeune, a medical doctor, and his friend Sadrac Bathard, a counseling major, to come to Ozark. Both men are current OCC students getting a biblical foundation to serve their countrymen.

Please pray for Luckner, Vladimir, Sadrac and all our international students.
