

One of my highest objectives is for my ministry to help you to grow in your faith. Jesus told Peter to feed his sheep. I am committed to the goal of providing quality Biblical messages for your spiritual growth, and to do this using creativity and fresh approaches.

We are fervently in prayer asking God to lead us and the elders in forming a vision for ERCC for the days to come. Spiritual growth and outreach are on my own heart. We trust in God to do great things. We humbly ask Him for His guidance.

Our start date is February 1, 2021. We are still in Louisiana as I write this. But, God willing, we hope and plan to be moved in and going strong by the 1st week of February.

We will be launching our "Front Porch Cookie Blitz" immediately after moving in. We will arrive at your porch, knock on your door, and then stand back to socially distance. We want to get to know you. We will chat outside for a short while and then leave you with some yummy cookies. We will not be entering into your home on this occasion, because we want to respect Covid guidelines. Our goal is simply to reach out to you and build a relationship with you.

"Draw Near" is the title of my first sermon series, and this will begin on February 7th. This series is based on James 4:8: "Draw near to God and He will draw near to you" (NKJV). The series will be about your relationship with God and your spiritual growth—How to draw near to God. I also encourage you to participate in our prayer walks. We will be announcing a schedule soon. The prayer walk provides a spiritual benefit, a physical benefit, a social benefit and a benefit for the outreach ministry of ERCC. We will meet at a park for group prayer for 5 or 10 minutes while socially distancing. Then each individual is encouraged to walk and pray privately. You choose your own walking pace and distance. Spending time in prayer and exercise is something we all need.

Don't miss the *Power Minute* video series. I plan to email you a YouTube video each day called *Power Minute*. Videos will be sent Monday through Friday for 5 weeks. These will be very short videos (aiming for 1 to 2 minutes) with a verse of Scripture and an insight from that verse. It is intended to encourage you each day to think on the things above and draw near to God.
