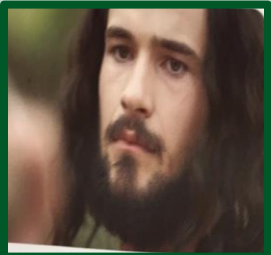

### DEAF MISSIONS: IMAGES FROM THE JESUS FILM



At ERCC we are committed to rebuilding our youth ministry and children’s ministry. We are in the process of searching for a new youth minister right now. We have received resumes and we have already conducted interviews. We hope to announce the new Youth Minister in June. In the meantime, youth activities are suspended at ERCC. Children and Youth will continue to attend adult worship on Sunday mornings. Pastor Mark is presenting a series on the Armor of God, and he is having the children participate in various ways.

### MISSION CORNER: DEAF MISSIONS

I know that you are surely VERY HAPPY. How do I know? Because Jesus said, “It is more blessed to give than to receive.” (Acts 20:35) Of course, He is right. The thing is, your gift to Deaf Missions is such a wonderful blessing to us that it is hard to imagine how you could be even more blessed. That’s how I know that you must be VERY happy ... you are even happier than we are.

When I first saw the Jesus Movie produced by the Jesus Film Project in 1979, I was super-impressed. It is thought to be the most-watched movie of all time. The dialogue of that movie has been translated into over 1,800 languages. I was so impressed that I had Deaf Missions to produce the movie with a corner inset where a hearing person signed all of the dialogue in the movie. That was wonderful, but the corner inset is not even close to being as effective as if the actors in the movie were actually using sign language.

Now, Deaf Missions is producing a new movie ... with DEAF actors all who are using SIGN LANGUAGE. The pilot scene is done. You can view it at [www.deafmissions.com/jesus](http://www.deafmissions.com/jesus). Completing the movie will require a few years and a whole lot of dollars. We are accustomed to those constraints, having completed the Bible translation into American Sign Language after 40 years and a whole lot of dollars. We are producing the Jesus movie so that, with the “magic” of technology, we can re-do it again and again in the variety of sign languages that are used around the world.

We want ALL deaf people to know Jesus.
